GENERAL

Quant Azimuth is a privately held company with limited liability under the laws of UAE, registered with the Companies Registry under ICC20210115 and registered office at Al Bateen Towers, C2 Building, Office 502, Al Bateen Area, Abu Dhabi, UAE, hereafter as the “**Company**”, and is detailed at www.quantazimuth.com, hereafter as the “**Website**”.

The Company process personal data in accordance with the General Data Protection Regulation (EU) 2016/679 (the “**GDPR**”). This GDPR & Privacy policy (“**Policy**”) describes how the Company collects personal data and how it is used by every “**User**”. By accessing our Website, the User agrees to this policy. If the User does not agree with any of the terms in this policy, the User is prohibited from using this Website. The User is responsible for compliance with any applicable local or regional laws or regulations.

The Company reserves the right to change this policy at any time without notification.

INFORMATION COLLECTED

For the purposes of delivering high-quality services, we need to collect personal data.

To maximize our services to our Users, we collect personal data in the event of the User completing the Website contact form. By completing this form, the User is giving the Company consent to process your personal data.

We collect the following data about you:

- First & Last name
- Email address

In cases that you send us a request or will communicate to us by any other means, then we may need to process your identification and contact details along with information you provide to us in order to effectively handle your request.

DATA RETENTION

Personal data collected and processed for the above-mentioned purposes will be kept for the duration of 10 years from the collection or until you revoke your consent.

DATA PROTECTION AND DISCLOSURE

We will maintain personal data with maximum security that is technically and financially feasible. Among other things, we have implemented these technical and organizational measures:

- anti-virus protection,
- computer security (use of usernames and passwords);
- data encryption (use of SSL certificate);
- restrictions on data storage and disposal;
- physical security (use of lockable entrance doors, entrance cards, lockers);
- regular data backup.

We may be obliged by law to disclose some data to public authorities.



YOUR RIGHTS

European Union Subjects • If you are located in the European Union then you have the following rights in connection with processing of your personal data: (1) the right of access to your personal data, (2) the right to rectification of inaccurate of your personal data, (3) the right to restriction to processing your personal data, (4) the right to erasure of your personal data, (5) the right to object to processing your personal data, (6) the right to revoke your consent, (7) the right to data portability and (8) the right to lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority. We need to verify your identity when you make a request to exercise any of the rights mentioned above. Please submit the request with the email address you have registered on your account.

Access to Data • You have the right to obtain information about the processing and the copy of your processed data, upon your request.

Right to Rectification • If you regard your personal data as incorrect or outdated, then you have the right to correct this data by contacting us with your new details, in case you cannot make the modifications yourself.

Restriction of Processing • As per GDPR Article 18, where the personal data under processing are inaccurate or you have objected to processing, you have the right to restrict said processing. For the period of the restriction, personal data shall only be stored with us and may not be subject to any other operation without your consent. The restriction of processing lasts for the duration of any of the above-described situations. You shall be informed of the expiration of such restriction.

Erasure • As per GDPR Article 17, when you withdraw your consent, or your personal data is no longer necessary, then you have the right to the deletion of your personal data. In some cases, the right to erasure is limited for compliance reasons or legal obligations.

Objections • In case of the processing based on your legitimate interests and/or for the purposes of direct marketing, you may raise an objection to the processing. The grounds for the objection will be assessed and you will be notified of the decision by the communication means as selected.

Withdrawing Consent • In the case of processing of your personal data based on consent, this consent may be withdrawn at any time.

Data Portability • You have the right to receive your personal data in a structured, machine-readable format.

Lodging a Complaint • If you consider that your personal data has been processed in breach of law, you have the right to lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority in alleged infringement's jurisdiction.

Cookies are small text files stored on your computer. The information that our cookies collect do not contain personally identifiable information. They are used by web developers to help users efficiently navigate our websites. Due to their core role of enhancing/enabling usability or site processes, disabling cookies may prevent you from using certain features.
